About the hymns:

- Carefully reviewed for metaphysical accuracy and professional musical quality
- Many new hymn texts along with familiar ones
 - Eight 20th-century classic hymns borrowed from other Christian hymnals, such as “Amazing Grace” and “Seek Ye First”
 - Twelve new poems, from Christian Scientists such as Violet Hay and Peter Henniker-Heaton, now set to music
 - Thirteen familiar texts from the *Hymnal* with new, alternate musical settings
- Music represents familiar hymns borrowed from Christian repertoire as well as newly composed hymns
 - Broad representation of musical styles with wide appeal to young people and church attendees today
 - Christian folk hymns, such as ones from Africa and the Caribbean, embracing churches in areas where Christian Science has grown since the publication of the *Hymnal* in 1932
 - Easy-to-sing vocal range for congregations
- Supplement in a separate binding offers new congregational music efficiently and inexpensively for both churches and the publisher.

Fun Facts: Did you know that ... ?

- During Mary Baker Eddy’s lifetime, there were five major *Hymnal* revisions (1892, 1898, 1903, 1905, and 1910).
- The selection and review work was done by committees.
- The *Hymnal* was not viewed as a static product.
- The last major revision and expansion of the *Hymnal* was in 1932, the edition still used today.
- The *Supplement* (2008) represents the first new congregational hymns offered for our services in 76 years.

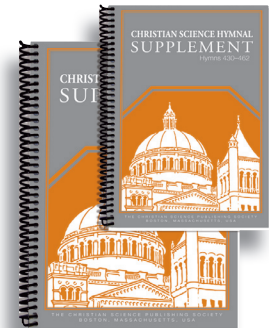

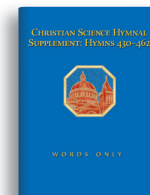
